#### **Entity's Purpose or Mission**

Bay of Islands Maritime Park Incorporated is a community environment awareness group. Its' Vision is "Waking up with brimming biodiversity. Native, naturally!" Its' Mission is "Restoring native life on land, in freshwater and the sea. Dream by dream!"

#### **Entity Structure**

Bay of Islands Maritime Park Incorporated has a co-governance structure with the Society's business being conducted within two Semi-Committees working together or separately (one for matters marine - "Fish Forever", and one for catchment matters - "Living Waters BOI-WaiOra").

Officer-bearers elected at an AGM or SGM shall be Co-Chair (Marine), Co-Chair (Catchment), Co-Secretary (Marine), Co-Secretary (Catchment) and Treasurer. Up to three ordinary Officers (committee members) may be elected to each Semi-Committee at the AGM, but supplementary committee members may be elected or appointed at notified meetings of either Semi-Committee.

Only members of the Society may be elected or appointed as Officers. The term of Officers is one year, but retiring Officers shall be eligible for re-election.

- Organised alien tree and weedclearance for Pipiroa Wetland restoration project and planting of 2200 nativetrees and flaxes. Funded and contracted pest control in Reserves.
- Organised alien tree and weedclearance in Wairoa Stream riparian reserve, and planted 1800 native trees. Maintained plantings made over previous 4 years.
- Organised planting of over 1000 native trees in the Rangitane Stream riparian restoration area. Maintained plantings made over previous two years.
- Resumed the Kanuka Baywatersheds and coastline ecological restoration project in Okiato to involve anew large landowner in animal & plant pest control, native revegetation and sediment control.

'How did we do our accounting?'

#### **Basis of Preparation**

The entity has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses equal to or less than \$2,000,000. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

#### **Goods and Services Tax**

The entity is registered for GST. All amounts are stated exclusive of goods and services tax (GST) except for accounts payable and accounts receivable which are stated inclusive of GST.

#### Income Tax

Bay of Islands Maritime Park Incorporated is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory conditions for these exemptions.

#### **Bank Accounts and Cash**

Bank accounts and cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturities of 90 days or less.

#### **Changes in Accounting Policies**

There have been no changes in accounting policies. Policies have been applied on a consistent basis with those of the previous reporting period.
