
## Fin Fish Farm Application 24.16 Hectares beside Peach Island

Te Runanga O Whaingaroa, through Whaingaroa Fisheries Limited has reactivated the 1996 application lodged by Hiwi Tauroa. The application has been publically notified by Northland Regional Council. Submissions close on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> November.

A summary of the application is attached. There is a bundle of supporting information which is available from NRC. The application is for 24.16 hectares beside Peach Island mainly for king fish farming – but also other species and shell fish too. The site is as follows:



The Whangaroa Maritime Recreational Park (WMRP) steering group which includes Tangata Whenua representation have been:

- Monitoring aquaculture developments
- Working to establish a maritime recreational park including the harbour and bay out to Stephensons Island.
- Involved as a party in the Environment Court case about NRC's Plan
   Change 4 establishing the new regime for aquaculture in Northland.
- Opposing the application by Westpac Mussells to establish a 125 hectare mussel farm inside Stephensons Island.

We believe the application is ill advised and entirely inappropriate for such a key position on our beautiful harbour.

## Briefly:

- There are technical issues as to whether Whaingaroa Fisheries Limited "own" the application.
- The application conflicts with NRC's agreement in mediation to exclude any further aquaculture inside the Whangaroa Harbour.
- The application conflicts with recreational boating in harbour.
- The application conflicts with maritime safety.
- Most importantly the application and proposed use create serious marine environmental risk.
- The economic and employment benefits touted by the applicant have been grossly overstated.
